

Attention all drivers.

What does the
diamond-shaped mark
on the road mean?



The diamond-shaped mark indicates **there is a pedestrian crossing (or bicycle crossing) ahead.**



Prepare to stop!

When you see the **diamond-shaped mark** while driving, take your foot off the accelerator and **be prepared to stop** for any pedestrians at the crosswalk ahead.



These signs indicate the presence of a crosswalk.

Pay attention to signs and markings to avoid overlooking them.

Stop!

Deceleration!

Pedestrian Priority!

When pedestrians are crossing or attempting to cross, you must come to a **temporary stop before the crosswalk** and yield the right of way to pedestrians.

Pay attention in situations like this!

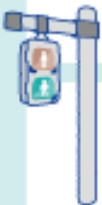


When a car is stopped before a crosswalk, **come to a temporary stop before proceeding** and check for safety.

Pedestrians also need to observe traffic rules.

Using Crosswalks

Pedestrians should use the crosswalks in the vicinity of where they are located!



Always obey traffic signals!

Even on a green light, make sure to look around carefully before crossing.

Prohibition of Diagonal Crossing

Pedestrians must not cross the road diagonally!



Prohibition of Crossing Immediately Before or After Vehicles

Pedestrians must not cross immediately before or after vehicles!



In places where there is a road sign indicating "No Pedestrian Crossing", you must not cross the road! Please use nearby crosswalks instead.
